No separate application; however, additional supporting documents are required for consideration. Awards are based on a holistic assessment, with particular emphasis on financial need, alongside academic achievement and overall applicant profile.

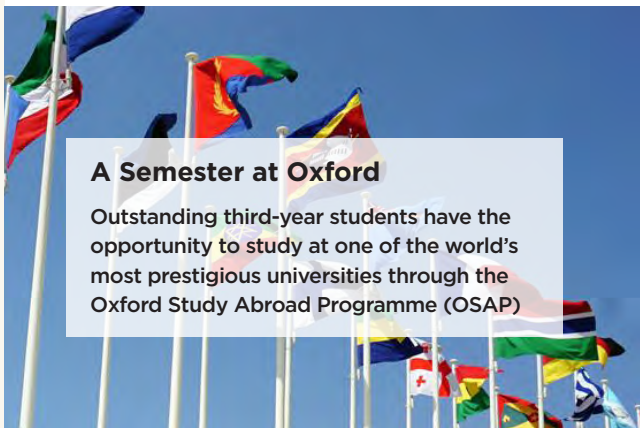
