Senior Lecturer Hospitality Management and Entrepreneurship

Full-time (40h/w)

The Department of Tourism and Service Management is seeking an outstanding scholar to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in the area of hospitality management as well as entrepreneurship and business planning in the hospitality and service industries (www.modul.ac.at/studyprograms). This is a full-time, unlimited contract where applicants are prepared to work 40 hours per week. This position is at the Senior Lecturer rank and provides opportunities to take leadership roles in various strategic fields of the university (e.g. Non-Degree Programs, Modul University Vienna Start-up Hub).

Responsibilities

- Teaching and conducting examinations independently (the standard teaching load for thisposition is 10 units/week per semester (1 unit = 45 minutes of teaching) including the time for supervising thesis
- · Directing the hotel and F&B operations and management education (Program Area Director)
- Establishing relationships with hotel and service industries stakeholders and developing a field of applied research related to the current and future challenges of this industry
- Contributing to the academic self-administration duties of the department and the university

Desired Qualifications

- · A doctorate in business administration or a related field
- Professional experience in the service industry (ideally in hospitality) is preferred
- · Fluent in the English and German language and a proven track record of teaching experience
- Interest to develop further and to take over responsibilities for important business fields of the university (e.g. Non-Degree Programs, Modul University Vienna Start-up Hub)
