**Entry requirements**: Successfully completed secondary education (e.g. Matura, Abitur, A-levels, International Baccalaureate) and an English proficiency test: **TOEFL** Internet-Based Test 76 (preferred minimum of 22 points in writing), **IELTS** band score 6.0 (no sub-score below 5.5 and a preferred minimum of 6.0 in writing), **Cambridge Certificate** (First Certificate in English preferred minimum grade B).
