



Master of Science in Sustainable Development, Management and Policy (MSc)

The Master of Science (MSc) in Sustainable Development, Management, and Policy is a two-year graduate program which exposes students to the wide range of sustainability issues, including their often complex interrelationships. Starting from at home all the way to the international level, the design and implementation of sustainable development programs and strategies is imperative to ensure future social, economic and environmental health, both locally and globally.

Duration: Two-year, full-time program

Language of instruction: English

Curriculum: Comprised of mandatory core courses as well as a range of enrichment courses.

Certificates: optional; students have the option to focus on one of four specialization areas: Advanced Management, Business Development, Real Estate Management and Hotel Development, or Tourism and Services Management

Master thesis: Mandatory

Program structure: Monday - Friday, full-time program. Earliest class begins at 8:30am, latest class begins at 6:00pm.

Tuition fees: €24,000 for the entire program, to be paid in four installments. Click here for more detailed information; ask about possible scholarships.

ECTS points: 120

Internship: Not mandatory, however students can opt to do an internship (6 ECTS points). This will count towards the required ECTS of either Leadership and Personal Skills or Enrichment Courses.

Entry requirements: Bachelor degree and English proficiency test (IELTS 6.5, TOEFL 88 etc.)
