

## **Academic Regulations for Changing Study Programs – from 223 MSc SDMP 2013 to 224 MSc SDMP 2016 (6/27/2016)**

**§ 1** From fall semester 2016 all new master of science students will either enrol in the 123 MSc ITM 2013, the 224 MSc SDMP 2016 or the 323 MSc MGMT 2016 study program.

**§ 2** The 223 MSc SDMP 2013 study program will remain in place until the end of fall semester 2017 and the respective Study Regulations will apply.

**§ 3** Students who have not completed the 223 MSc SDMP 2013 curriculum by the end of fall semester 2017 will be required to change to the 224 MSc SDMP 2016 study program. § 4 (2) – (5) apply.

**§4** Students currently enrolled may apply to transfer from 223 MSc SDMP 2013 to the 224 MSc SDMP 2016 study program.

- (1) The earliest date for graduating from the 224 MSc SDMP 2016 study program is July 2017.
- (2) The applications for program transfer have to be submitted to the academic office two months prior to the subsequent semester at the latest and the Dean decides on the study program transfer.
- (3) Rules on additional fees may apply as defined and announced by the University Board.
- (4) Course credits obtained in the 223 MSc SDMP 2013 study program are eligible for transfer according to the course equivalency overview in § 5.
- (5) All transferred grades will be taken into consideration for the calculation of the grade point average (GPA) and the total ECTS.
