1) Grading Scales

Grading Scale for students enrolling **before** 2013 (§7 (5) ER):

Grade (Austrian Scale)	Equivalent to	% Points
1	Excellent	80-100
2	Good	70-79
3	Average	60-69
4	sufficient	51-59
5	Fail	50-0

Grading Scale for students enrolling in 2013 and after (§7 (4) ER):

Grade (Austrian Scale)	Equivalent to	% Points
1	Excellent	90-100
2	Good	80-89
3	Average	70-79
4	sufficient	60-69
5	Fail	59-0

2) Grading Scale Transformation Tables

Referring to the different grading schemes (§7(4) and (5) exam regulations) the following transformation scheme is used in order to transfer grades from a new (2013+ curricula) to an old (previous curricula) study program:

Grade according to the new grading scheme	pts deducted to reflect the old grading scheme §7 (5)
0-3 or 100	No change
4-10 or 99	-1
11-17 or 98	-2
18-23 or 97	-3
24-30 or 96	-4
31-37 or 95	-5
38-43 or 94	-6
44-50 or 93	-7
51-57 or 92	-8
58-65 or 91	-9
66-90	-10



The grades of students who transfer from the old to the new study program are transformed using the following transformation scheme:
