- Excellent written and spoken English (German is not a requirement as English is the working language).

We expect the successful candidate to

- Have a career ambition to conduct internationally recognized research.
- Enthusiastically engage in teaching undergraduate courses.
- Assist in the general administration of the university.

Two positions and scholarships are available as of September 2014 for a duration of four years. Successful candidates will be enrolled in MU's PhD in Business and Socioeconomic Sciences and use about 50% of their working hours (40h/week) for their PhD studies. The starting salary is EUR 25,000 gross (annual teaching load: two units à 45 min. of weekly teaching). From the 2nd year onwards, the salary increases to EUR 32,800 gross with an annual teaching load of six units per semester. Additional allowances are available; tuition for the PhD program (EUR 11,250 per year) is covered by MODUL University Vienna.
