## FAQS

*Do I have to speak German to participate in this program?*

No! The entire program will be conducted in English. You must speak English at a B1-Intermediate level in order to fully participate in the Summer Program.

*Where will the participants sleep?*

Participants will be accommodated in a hotel near the university, with two students in each room. The students will be transported by bus every day to and from the day's events.

*Will there be supervision?*

A representative of the university will be with the students at all times, including staying in the hotel, in case of any emergencies or unforeseen circumstances. The representative's mobile number will be provided for emergency contact.

*What if I need a visa to come to Austria?*

If you are from a non-EU country, you may need to apply for a tourist visa to travel to Austria. You should not require a letter of invitation to travel as a tourist; please check with your embassy or consulate. EU citizens do not require additional medical insurance but are encouraged to take out an additional travel insurance policy (for non-Austrians).

*Will I receive academic credits for this program?*

No, you will not. The Summer Program is designed for students to become acquainted with MU and its programs and also to get a feel for life in Vienna. Participants will not receive any kind of academic credits.
